

Incentive Programs: *Whole House Upgrade*



Basic Package: \$1,000 rebate

- For homes with R-19 or less attic insulation, leaky air ducts, *and* air leakage areas
- Pre-testing
 - Combustion safety testing
 - Blower Door test to quantify and identify locations of air leakage
 - Duct Blaster test to quantify duct leakage
- Upgrade measures:
 - air sealing
 - duct sealing
 - attic insulation to R-38 or more
 - hot water pipe and/or tank insulation, if needed
 - carbon monoxide and smoke detectors, if needed
- Post-testing
 - Combustion safety testing to assure no combustion problems have developed
 - Blower Door test to assure house meets sealing goal
 - Duct Blaster test to assure ducts meet sealing goal

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Performance Package:

- \$2,000 for 20% efficiency improvement,
 - plus more for each 5%,
 - up to \$3,500 for 40% efficiency improvement
- Comprehensive test-in and test-out
- Energy efficiency computer modeling
- Shell measures listed above + system upgrades, which may include
 - wall insulation
 - furnace
 - air conditioning
 - air ducts
 - pool pump
 - windows

More Incentive Programs

- “Traditional” PG&E rebates for efficient dishwashers, clothes washers, room AC, water heaters, pool pumps, insulation, furnace
- Cash for Appliances, while funds last: refrigerators, clothes washers, dishwashers, water heaters, furnace, AC
- State rebates for solar thermal hot water systems, solar photovoltaic
- Federal tax credits for qualifying furnace, AC, insulation, cool roof, water heater, windows & doors through 12/31/2010 – consult your tax advisor
- Federal tax credits for solar energy systems through 2016 – consult your tax advisor
